The Use of Structural Funds for Growth in Poland

26 June 2007, Hyatt Regency Warsaw, 23 Belwederska Avenue

In the context of the main objective of the conference, which is the discussion on the effective use of Structural Funds in Poland, we are interested in the strategic theses of the European regional policy in the years 2007-2013 aimed at contributing to economic growth and raising investments in research and development. **In particular, an attempt will be undertaken to answer the question, whether the use of Structural Funds in Poland should serve the bridging of development disproportions or rather supporting 'development locomotives'. We would also like to define the institutional, legal and social barriers to spending European funds at central and local level and to confer on the possibilities of limiting those barriers.**

The conference will gather representatives of various institutions and circles engaged in using Structural Funds: European Commission, central and self-government authorities, enterprises, universities and non-governmental organisations. During the conference opinions will be presented both by experts dealing with regional policy and practitioners from Poland and other member states.

The working languages of the conference will be Polish and English. The organisers guarantee simultaneous interpretation.
